

**Motion to the SRC regarding financial accountability of student events
held on University land**

14th October 2008

This SRC notes:

- That there has been a rise in the number of student events held on University land, and that more students than ever before are attending such events;
- That the University has recently created an Events Management Group to co-ordinate events held on University property;
- That there is currently no requirement either in law or from the University for student groups organising events to release details of the accounts of any event.

This SRC believes:


- That accountability and transparency should be at the heart of everything the University and its students do;
- That students purchasing tickets to events have a right to know how their money is spent, particularly with regard to charitable functions.

This SRC resolves:

- To mandate the Association President and Director of Representation to write to the Proctor and the Director of Residential & Business Services with the following recommendations:
 1. That the Events Management Group should stipulate that all student groups holding events on University land should produce full accounts for any given event upon request;
 2. That groups which fail to satisfy such a request within a reasonable period of time will not be permitted to hold any further events until they comply.
