

Motion to the SSC and SRC to prohibit Association – Affiliated Societies from fly-postering on non University property.

This SRC/SSC notes:

- That fly-postering in St Andrews is illegal;
- That the University is taking an increasing stronger stance in dealing with fly postering by threatening to remove the use of rooms from societies that do this;
- That the non-student residents in St Andrews strongly and actively disapprove of fly-postering.

This SRC/SSC believes:

- That the issue of Affiliated societies fly-postering needs immediately addressing to avoid future problems with the University;
- That by prohibiting fly-postering, a positive student image can be conveyed to the town.

This SRC/SSC resolves:

- To prohibit Affiliated societies from fly-postering with immediate effect;
- To mandate both the Association President and the Association Community Relations Officer to inform the wider community on the former point should the issue be raised;
- To inform ALL Affiliated societies that Town byelaws and University legislation prohibit fly-postering. This should be achieved through the SSC Societies Officer and Committee, and Societies Training Events;
- To encourage Societies to advertise in alternative ways, such as, for example, through The Saint, In Focus Magazine, and the new Student Event Section in the Citizen.
