Change Committee Terms of Reference

Organisational Purpose

The Change Committee (CC) is a specialised subcommittee established by the Board of Trustees of St Andrews Students' Association (StASA). Its primary purpose is to oversee the Change Programme, led by a Change Director; selected by this committee. The committee is no longer a decision-making body and therefore voting powers are not defined within these terms.

Responsibilities:

- recruit, and maintain the Change Director/Team
- provide feedback on plans and progress reports presented by the Change Team in line with objectives of the Change Programme
- provide the priorities of the Change Programme
- endorse and promote the Change Plan(s) across the institution(s)
- monitor and provide input on key risks and issues impacting the Change Programme
- promoting collaborative working across the Change Programme
- monitor the work completed by the Change Team ensuring it lies within the overall motives and priorities of the Change Programme
- approve and when appropriate compose all communications relating to the Change Programme- internally and externally
- manage and ensure accountability of the Change Director
- raise matters to the attention of the SA Board, as required
- provide updates to the SA Board at Board meetings
- monitor the expenditure of the Change Programme and ensure the Programme remains within budget

Membership

1 x Trustee

Core membership will regularly meet with the Change Director to monitor progress of the Change Programme.

The extended membership will attend meetings as appropriate, such as to hear significant updates and progress reports.

Membership will be reviewed by the Core Membership, as required

Meetings

The core membership will meet with the Change Director once a month. Any core member of the committee can call an extraordinary meeting of the Change Committee. Minutes should be taken in each meeting.
