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This SRC Notes:

1. That the current Student Representative Council (SRC) structure has served as the representative body for students within the Students' Association.
2. That the Democracy Review, adopted following extensive consultation and upheld by the Students' Association Board, outlined significant reforms to the representative structures of the Association.
3. That the referendum on these reforms saw 78% of votes in favour of the proposed changes, and while turnout was below the binding threshold, the Association Board of Trustees unanimously agreed to implement them, on 17 December 2024.
4. This is the final meeting of the SRC before the upcoming elections will be the first under the newly approved model, replacing the current SRC format.

This SRC Believes:

1. That the SRC has played a vital role in advocating for students and ensuring their voices are heard within the Association and the wider University community.
2. That the transition to the outlined governance structure will provide renewed representation, enhanced support for officers and ultimately better reflect the needs and views of the student body.
3. That it is important to formally recognise and thank all members of the SRC, past and present, for their commitment and service.

This SRC Resolves:

1. To formally dissolve the current SRC at the conclusion of its term, in line with the implementation of the new representative structure as outlined in the Democracy Review.

2. To extend a heartfelt thank you to all current and former SRC members for their dedication, hard work, and contributions to student life.
3. To ensure a smooth transition to the new model by providing appropriate support and resources to both outgoing and incoming representative officers.
